IHRO VISION 2020

This simplified version of the 30 Articles of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights has been created especially for you to know.

We at IHRO have chosen these 11 articles to work on priority till 2020

1. We Are All Born Free & Equal. We are all born free. We all have our own thoughts and ideas. We should all be treated in the same way.
2. The Right to Life. We all have the right to life, and to live in freedom and safety.
3. No Slavery. Nobody has any right to make us a slave. We cannot make anyone our slave.
4. We're All Equal Before the Law. The law is the same for everyone. It must treat us all fairly.
5. Your Human Rights Are Protected by Law. We can all ask for the law to help us when we are not treated fairly.
6. Freedom of Expression. We all have the right to make up our own minds, to think what we like, to say what we think, and to share our ideas with other people.
7. Social Security. We all have the right to affordable housing, medicine, education, and childcare, enough money to live on and medical help if we are ill or old.
8. Food and Shelter for All. We all have the right to a good life. Mothers and children, people who are old, unemployed or disabled, and all people have the right to be cared for.
9. The Right to Education. Education is a right. Primary school should be free. We should learn about the United Nations and how to get on with others. Our parents can choose what we learn.
10. Responsibility. We have a duty to other people, and we should protect their rights and freedoms.
11. No One Can Take Away Your Human Rights.



RIGHT TO HEALTHCARE

Access to health care is a vital human right. While millions of people in India suffer from the inability to access basic health care services, IHRO works persistently to empower rural populations for accessing health care services as their basic human right.

Organ donation initiative – In other words, “Organ donation is life donation.” A desired organ reaching a recipient in time, bolsters his or her ‘Human Right to Life’. Leading this initiative with partner organizations, IHRO aims to minimize the deaths due to organ failure by providing organ transfers pan India.

Health Camps Rural Medical Camps - We will work in rural areas to set up medical health camps that provide health care services and workshops for creating awareness regarding nutrition, hygiene and sanitation, neo-natal and ante-natal care, family planning methods, and many other topics.





RIGHT TO SUSTAINABILITY

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), known as the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, by the United Nations enlists many issues that need to be addressed for sustainable development in the coming decade. Human rights and these sustainable development goals (SDGs) are closely interwoven, and that is what comprises the 'Human Right to Sustainability' for us. Fulfillment of human rights of every strata of the society is possible in the long term only if development is done in a sustainable manner. In line with the SDGs, IHRO is working towards Solar Electrification of rural areas in India. Solar energy is a renewable source of energy and has immense potential for use in villages.

Similarly, we are processing the installation of 'Water Purification Units' in water deficient areas in eastern India. Helping people readily avail clean drinking water at low costs can usher in great benefits. We are looking at installing these units with the help of the local community and then train the locals to operate and maintain them. This will help create a self-sustaining model, whilst generating employment as well.



HUMAN RIGHTS ADVOCACY

Human Rights violations are our primary concern and we have extended a helping hand to numerous individuals who have experienced traumatic situations. We hope to grow as a reliable institution in the coming future for addressing and providing timely resolution to human right issues.

Legal aid - We have worked rigorously with community based organizations, local authorities and legal bodies for active resolution of issue like custodial violence, sexual harassment, domestic violence, child labour and abuse, bonded labour, and many such issues.

Rehabilitation - “Everyone has the right to work, to free choice of employment, to just and favorable conditions of work and to protection against unemployment”. All individuals need a second chance. For prisoners who have been disconnected from the society due to their term it is indispensable that they are given avenues for integration back into the society.



RIGHT TO ART, CULTURE & SCIENCE

As United Nations Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) sites in Article 27, “Everyone has the right freely to participate in the cultural life of the community, to enjoy the arts and to share in scientific advancement and its benefits.” All individuals are entitled to the right of expressing themselves through arts, culture and scientific pursuits. It is quite valid that this aspect is essential in cultural and social growth of every nation.


Keeping in view the arts, cultural activities and a scientific bent of mind, we engage with stakeholders and provide a niche area for full expression of this potential among women, youth and marginalized segments of society.
